42/2026 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

45/2026 STANDING ITEM – CLIMATE AND ECOLOGY EMERGENCY:

The committee noted the Council's commitment to embed the Climate and Ecology Emergency Declaration across all activities, ensuring environmental impacts are considered in a fully integrated approach to climate change mitigation.

46/2026 0263/26 & 0264/26: Refurbishing and remodelling of the main house, constructing a new outdoor swimming pool and field kitchen, new opening to walled garden and landscaping works, with variation of Conditions 2, 6 and 8 attached to planning permission ref: 0177/24 dated 07 October 2024 at Hayne Old Manor, Moretonhampstead, TQ13 8SB

Cllr Short provided an overview of the proposed variations to the conditions attached to the planning permission and listed building consent granted in October 2024. Members noted that the original

approvals included ten listed building conditions and eleven planning conditions, and that a number have since been discharged.

Cllr Short summarised that the proposal represents highly technical variation and fall primarily within the remit of the Dartmoor National Park heritage officer.

It was proposed by Cllr Fileman-Wright, seconded by Cllr Hodges, and **RESOLVED** that the council has no objection to the planning and listed building amendments.
